



Since June 2016, the largest maritime history collection in the Western Hemisphere has been completely inaccessible to anyone—including staff. Now, thanks to grant funding from private foundations and corporations, as well as gifts from individuals, nearly all of this world-renowned collection is available for research. The collection holds more than two million books, magazines, manuscripts, maps, vessel plans, newspaper articles, photographs, Chris-Craft archives, and Museum archives and is now accessible, due to the purchase and installation of compact shelving.
