


- The Park is 550 acres with the 167-acre Mariners' Lake.
- Mariners' Park was established in 1930 by Archer and Anna Hyatt Huntington to create a wildlife sanctuary and park.
- In 1991, the five-mile Noland Trail was created. The Trail hosts more than 100,000 guests every year.
